W/T Classes, Ground Pole Hunter & Crossrail Hunter

Open to all riders and horses. Ground Pole Hunters must W/T all classes. Crossrail Hunters may W/T over fences without penalty, but must W/T/C on the flat. May not cross enter any other classes over fences.

Short Stirrup Hunter is a horse or pony of any age or showing experience ridden by a Junior exhibitor who has not reached their 11th birthday by December 1 of 2009. Riders may not have shown over 2' in USEF classes, with the exception of 11 & Under Equitation over fences. Rule applies to Short Stirrup Hunter classes as well as Short Stirrup Equitation classes. Fence height: 18" to 2' at all shows.

Beginner Rider Hunter is a horse or pony ridden by an amateur exhibitor who has not won three blue ribbons over fences at any USEF or locally recognized show prior to December 1 of 2009. Equitation classes are included. Ribbons won in Short Stirrup do not affect the rider's status for this division. Riders may cross enter 2'6" classes but may not show as a Beginner after competing in classes 3' or higher. Fence height: 2' at all shows

Schooling Hunter is an open division.

Children's Hunter Pony is a pony ridden and handled in all phases of competition by a Junior exhibitor. The same rider and/or pony may enter any equitation classes. Fence Height: 2' for small & medium (13.2hh and under) 2'6" for large ponies (13.3hh – 14.2hh) Spread not to exceed height of fence.

Baby Green Hunter is open to any horse or pony in its first year of USEF or locally recognized showing over fences. Fence Height: 2' to 2'6"

Novice Hunter is open to any horse or pony who has not won three blue ribbons over fences in any USEF or locally recognized show. Fence Height: 2' to 2'6"

Limit Rider Hunter is a horse or pony ridden by a Junior or Amateur Adult exhibitor who has not won six blue ribbons over fences at any USEF or locally recognized show prior to December 1 of 2009. Equitation classes are included. Ribbons won over fences 2'3" or less in height do not affect the rider's status for this division. Riders may cross enter 2'6" classes but may not show in Limit classes after competing in classes 3'6" or higher. Fence height: 2'6" at all shows

Novice Child/Adult Hunter is open to any horse or pony ridden by an amateur who has not competed over fences in any USEF or locally recognized class in which fence height exceeds 3'3". Number of ribbons does not affect rider's status in this division. A rider may cross enter into Children's or any other 3' division at the same show but not riding the same horse entered in this division. Fence height: 2'9" at all shows

Pre-Green Hunter is a horse of any age in its first or second year of showing in any classes over fences 3' or higher, including equitation classes, at any USEF or locally recognized show. Once a horse has shown 3'6" he is no longer eligible to compete in this division. Fence Height: 2'9" to 3' at all shows

Child/Adult Hunter is a horse or pony ridden and handled in all phases of competition by a Junior exhibitor. The same rider/horse(pony) combination may not compete at the same show in any class (equitation excepted) in which the fence height exceeds 3'3". Horses and ponies entered in the Children's Hunter division may not cross enter into the Novice Children's Hunter division on the same horse at the same competition. Courses will not be adjusted for ponies. Entries may be required to jog for soundness. Fence height: 2'9" to 3'. Spread not to exceed fence height.

12 to 14 Equitation is open to Junior exhibitors who have reached their 12th birthday but have not reached their 15th birthday by December 1, 2009. Fence height: 3' at all shows.

15 to 17 Equitation is open to Junior exhibitors who have reached their 15th birthday but have not reached their 18th birthday by December 1, 2009. Fence height: 3'6" at all shows.

Intro Rider Jumper is open to any horse or pony ridden by a Junior or amateur adult in their first or second year of showing in USEF or locally recognized Jumper classes. Fence height: 2' to 2'6"

Novice Jumper is open to any horse or pony in its first or second year of showing in USEF or locally recognized jumper classes. Fence height: 2'6"

Level II Jumpers – 3' - 3'3"

Level III Jumpers – 3'3 - 3'6"

Level IV Jumpers – 3'6 - 3'9"

Coggins Tests must be presented to the show secretary before numbers are issued. **Hard Hats** must be worn at all times when mounted. Juniors must wear protective harness. Proper attire includes britches and hard soled shoes. Polo shirts may be worn.

Warm Up Classes: A warm up class will be open throughout the entire hunter show. A horse may be entered once. An entry fee must be paid and all warmup rounds will be judged as a single class.

Stalls are limited in number and must be reserved in advance. First bedding is provided. The cost is \$40 for the show. **All horses without stalls must pay a \$15 grounds fee. NON-SHOWING horses** must pay a schooling fee (\$15) grounds fee (\$15) and the office fee (\$10) BEFORE schooling. They must also provide a negative Coggins test upon arrival.

Adding at the Gate: A scratch/add sheet must be to the announcer's stand prior to the start of the class. Scratch/add sheets can be found at the in-gate.

Cornerstone students who register at least one week in advance benefit from a \$10 per class entry fee, and must pay \$5 per class for the use of a school horse. School horses will be reserved on a first-come, first-paid basis. Registration opens Saturday three weeks before the show.

Championships and Ribbons: Six ribbons will be awarded in each class. Champion and Reserve ribbons will be awarded to the top two horses in each division. All MOHJO, MHSA and MISHO members will receive DOUBLE POINTS for their placings. **Series High Point Awards:** Participants who compete in 3 out of 5 of our 2010 Show Series will be eligible to win a high point series award. We traditionally award silver, tack and 48" Championship & Reserve ribbons at our annual Christmas Hunt Ball.

Schooling is allowed in the main arena from 1 pm on Friday until ½ hour prior to show start both days. Schooling is also allowed after the show.

Dressage Tests – Readers are allowed.
